Journey Details

October 14, 2018

Meet & Greet at San Jose (Intl Juan Santamaria) - A representative of the Costa Rica board of tourism, Canatur, will meet you after you have cleared immigration and provide you with name tags that identify you as a client of Way to Go Costa Rica. After clearing customs, you will exit the terminal. There, you will see a representative of our destination management company, Destination Costa Rica, holding a placard with your name. You will be presented with your vouchers and a general info kit. Pickup times for tours and transfers will be stamped on each voucher.

Guided Transfer from San Jose -

DESTINATION: Arenal Volcano is approximately 3000 years old and has an elevation of 5500 feet. Though in a resting phase the volcano's geothermal activity heats the local mineral springs. Surrounded by lush rain forest, the area offers the most touring options. The area is rich in natural attractions; experience thermo-mineral hot springs, waterfall hikes, horseback riding, birdwatching, biking, and boat tours on the Cano Negro.

Vida Campensina Farm Tour - An organic farm offering educational tours where visitors interact while they learn responsible production in harmony with the environment. At the farm you will find Costa Rica's thriving crops: sugar cane, coffee, corn, yucca, cocoa, bananas and plantains; as well as non-traditional crops such as Chinese potato and yam. Take part in activities such as milking a cow, making tortillas and collecting water from our handmade well. Then proceed to the barn mill and enjoy a delicious sugar cane juice which you can squeeze yourself in a handmade trapiche and even try a shot of sugar cane liquor. You will also have the opportunity to collaborate with the environment by sponsoring and planting a tree. Then enjoy a typical organic Costa rican lunch prepared with farm products and cooked on a wood stove.

Arenal Hanging Bridges & Ecotermals Hot Springs - Arenal Hanging Bridges is located within a 618-acre reserve of primary forest. Interspersed along a 2-mile rainforest circuit are 15 bridges from 5 to 100 yards in length.& Designed by structural engineers with the most demanding safety margins in the world, the bridges are built of aluminum, galvanized steel and concrete. From the forest floor and the elevated

bridges, your naturalist guide will help you explore the fascinating world of the tropical rainforest. The imposing vistas of the volcano from the hanging bridges over the forest make a perfect combination for an unforgettable experience. Afterwards, enjoy a healthy and relaxing soak at the hot springs, followed by dinner.

The residents in the animal sanctuary are all rescue animals and include: Sloths, Monkeys, Pumas, Jaguars, Toucans and more. Diamante has dozens of species of frogs, snakes, birds and a world-class butterfly observatory.
